



Hatch-ed With Love

Guardian Angels

Designed by Jen Hatch

Materials:

The pattern will work up nicely in any yarn you choose!!
I used worsted weight yarn for one and crochet thread for the other.
In my samples, I used an E hook with the worsted weight and a B hook with the crochet thread.

Gauge:

Is not really important, you need to just use a size hook to get the size you would like.
My worsted weight angel measures about 5 inches from top of head to the edge of skirt.
My crochet thread angel measures about 4 inches from top of head to the edge of skirt.

HEAD: (head and body will be worked as one piece):

Rnd 1: Ch 4, (counts as first dc) 11 dc in first ch, join with sl st to top of first dc (12)

Rnd 2: Ch 3, (counts as first dc) dc in same as joining, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st to top of first dc. (24)

To work the dress you will work in rows.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in same as joining, dc in each of next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st, leaving remaining sts unworked. (8)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, Dc in same st, dc in each of 6 sts, 2 dc in next st. (10)

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, Dc in same st, dc in each of next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st. (12) Fasten off White.

Joining Contrasting color with sl st, *Ch 3, sl st in next st, repeat across.

For a Fuller skirt (optional): Joining Contrasting color, *Ch 3, sc in same sp, sc in next sp. Repeat across, fasten off.

HALO:

Ch 20, being careful not to twist the ch, join with sl st in first ch, sl st in each ch around, fasten off. Leaving a long tail to use for sewing.

WINGS:

Row 1: Ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook

Row 2: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next st. (2)

Row 3: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each st. (4)

Row 4: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st (6)

Row 5: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st (8)

Row 6: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st (10)

Row 7: ch 3, dc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sl st in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, dc in each of next 3 st, ch 3, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

To do the other side of wing. With right side facing, join yarn at the tip of the wing with sl st.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in same st.

Row 9: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next st, (2)

Row 10: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts. (4)

Row 11: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st (6)

Row 12: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st (8)

Row 13: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st. (10)

Row 14: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sl st in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, dc in each of next 3 sts, ch 3, sl st in last st. Fasten off. Leaving a long tail to use for sewing.

Assembly.

Sew Halo to top of head. Making sure to sew through all layers so it stays in place.

Sew the wings to the center of the back of body.
